## INFORMATION/INSTRUCTIONS Pro Treatment Proceedings

Pre Treatment Precautions:		
☐ It is important that the area being treated <i>not be exposed to the sun</i> . A broad-		
spectrum (UVA/UVB) sunscreen of 30 SPF or higher should be applied whenever		
area to be treated is exposed to the sun. This practice should continue between		
treatments and following your last treatment for at least 6 weeks.		
Hyper-pigmentation (dark patches of skin), or hypo-pigmentation (white patches of		
skin) can result if treated area is exposed to the sun.		
□ <b>DO NOT</b> use <b>Retin-A or Renova</b> one week prior to laser treatment.		
□ <b>DO NOT</b> take <b>Accutane</b> for six months prior to laser treatment.		
<b>DO NOT</b> pluck, tweeze, thread, wax or use depilatory agents treatment.		
The area <b>should be</b> shaved 24-48 hours prior to treatment. Stubble is needed		
to visualize area. If the area being treated has a heavy hair growth, you should		
shave just prior to coming for treatment.		
<b>DO NOT</b> wear <b>make-up</b> , <b>deodorant</b> , <b>perfumes or powder</b> on the areas to be		
treated.		
☐ Plan to avoid tight elastic at the leg opening, following bikini treatments,		
for 3-5 days.		
☐ If you have a history of genital or oral herpes ( <b>fever blisters</b> ) and are having		
this area treated, you will need to have your physician prescribe suppressive		
therapy and take as directed. We cannot not treat during an active outbreak.		
<b>□</b> We will not perform your laser treatment if you have a suntan, sunburn,		
have used self-tanning creams or are on medications that cause photosensitivity because of the likelihood of hyper-pigmentation or hypo-		
		nigmentation.

Pos	t Treatment Precautions:
	Treat the area delicately. Do not rub, scratch or pick the treated area.
	If the treated area becomes tender or shows signs of infection such as pus,
tend	derness, or if you develop a fever, contact one of our laser technicians at
541	<b>-770-6776</b> immediately.
	Avoid swimming, sports, and strenuous exercise for two to three days
foll	owing treatment.
	Do not shave the area if crusting or blistering occurs.
	Do not use hot water on treated areas immediately following treatments.
<u>Car</u>	re of the Treated Area:
	If crusting or blistering occurs apply a light coat of antibacterial ointment
suc	h as Polysporin, to the treated area as often as necessary to keep the area moist.
	Keep the treated area clean.
	Discomfort, such as swelling or redness can be relieved with Tylenol or by
app	lying ice.
	It is best not to use make-up for three days on the treated area. If make-up is a
mus	st, you should apply and remove it very delicately. Excessive rubbing can cause
trau	ima to the area and may increase the chance of scarring or hyper-pigmentation.
	Treated hair will exfoliate or push out in approximately two to three weeks
(soı	metimes sooner), and may appear darker and thicker before falling out.
	Do not shave for a minimum of 3 days post treatment.
	Do not occlude the underarm with deodorant for three days. Use a light
pov	vder instead.
	When showering, always gently rinse with cool or tepid water and gently pat
the	area dry. <i>Do not rub</i> .
